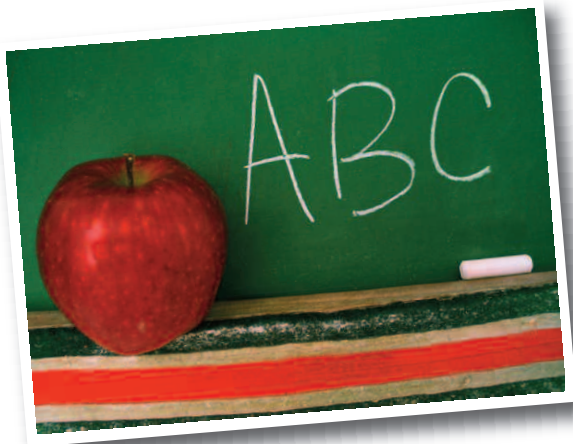

Other Good Health Habits (from the CDC)

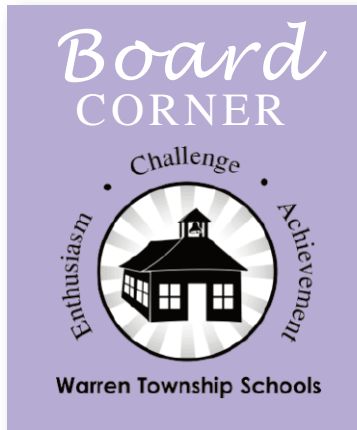
1. Avoid close contact with those who are sick.

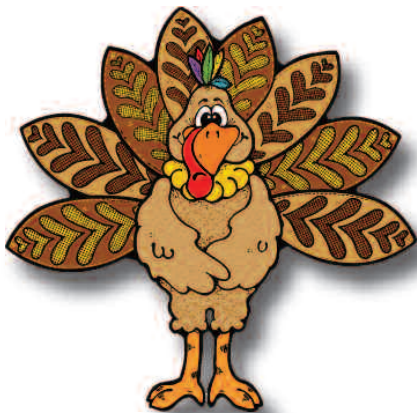

### 21st Century Fluencies Initiative

Warren Township teachers and administrators will work together in November in a 2-day training institute to begin planning lessons and units that incorporate 21st century “fluencies” in classrooms across the district. With the concept of “global digital citizenship” as an underlying foundation to all program development, teachers will link more authentic, integrated problem-solving opportunities to their curriculum. Following a kick-off presentation by internationally-known speaker Lee Crockett on October 11th, a pilot group of teachers representing all schools will examine their curriculum content to find appropriate areas where a structured, project-based approach can provide students with opportunities to collaborate as they solve problems and to use technology to access, evaluate, and present information about a solution. The goal of the initiative is to develop lessons and units that address traditional curriculum and standards while cultivating 21st-century fluencies in our students. Core teachers will implement these lessons in their classrooms and will share their experiences with their colleagues.
