

February is Dental Health Month

Please reinforce the importance of **good oral hygiene** to your children.

- The teeth and the tongue should be brushed at least twice daily (morning and evening).
- Floss daily!
- Change your toothbrush every 3 months and after illness.
- The ADA recommends check-ups every 6 months for school age children.
- Keep hands away from your mouth and nose to avoid germs

- Include more fruits and vegetables in your diet
