Now is also the time to register for our regular school year before/after-care program through AlphaBEST. Details can be found at www.alphabest.org/warrennj/.


Schools reopen for students on Tuesday, September 3. Have a wonderful summer!

A FEW REMINDERS..... from Mrs. Brennan

- If you need any information on your child for summer camp, (immunizations or medication orders) please contact me.
- **A parent/guardian** is required to pick up medications during the **last week of school**; medications will not be given to students; medications not picked up will be discarded.
- Your physician must complete medication forms for the **2019-20** school year dated **after July 1, 2019**.
- Fifth grade students who are planning to try-out for **any** sport in Middle School are required to have a **Warren District Sports physical form completed by your physician and a health questionnaire form by a parent/guardian**. Please go to the WMS website for other sports information. They use an online system for submission of all sports forms!
- **Immunization requirements for 6th grade include Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines. Please send in the documentation for the completed vaccines. This is A NJ state regulation.**
