Dear Parent/Guardian,

Boards of Education are required to have voluntary fingerprinting available to students. The Somerset County Sheriff's Office and Warren Township Schools coordinate efforts to provide this service.

If your child has already been fingerprinted, disregard this letter. If your child has not been fingerprinted, and you are considering it, the following information will be beneficial to you.

- 1. Fingerprinting helps reduce the number of missing children by facilitating their location and identification.
- 2. Any student who has not already been fingerprinted (Project Grow, kindergartners, children new to Warren schools, students whose parents now choose to have their child fingerprinted) is eligible.
- 3. Representatives from the County Sheriff's Child Identification Unit, aided by a representative from the Warren Township Police, do the fingerprinting. You may be present if you wish. Records will not be kept in school. They will be sent home with your child.
