SESSION 1: Elements of Art

During this first session, students are exposed to the building blocks of art education, through the introduction to the simple, yet necessary, elements of line, shape, color and texture.



SESSION 2: Drawing

SESSION 3: Painting

Introduction to both representational and abstract techniques to create work based on their imagination and environment. The creation of mixed-media pieces ensures some exceptional work!



SESSION 4: Three Dimensions

The use of clay transitions artwork to threedimensions. The physical manipulation introduces advanced spatial relationship and motor skills, while encouraging greater understanding of height, width, depth and texture.
