**Thursday, October 22 from 7-8 pm**

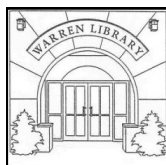
Celebrate Comic Con and Halloween with us! We will be playing games, hosting trivia contest, and much more! Come in costume to participate in our costume contest as well.
