About Buddy Ball: The Bambino Buddy Ball Division was established by Babe Ruth Baseball as a program for children with special needs. The most fundamental goal of Buddy Ball is to give everyone a chance to play, regardless of disability. Buddy Ball features volunteer "buddies" who help by assisting the players when needed. Today, more than 30,000 players participate in a Buddy Ball type league nationwide.

Eligibility: Children with disabilities from the local area, ages of 5-20, are eligible to participate.

Game Information: There will be one Buddy Ball game per week, on a weekend day, from April through June. No practices, just pregame warm-up.

Registration: will begin December 1, each year. To register a player, go to <u>www.warrenbaseballsoftball.com</u>. Click on *Register Online*, then *Begin Registration*, under the Buddy Ball section. There is no registration fee to play in this league.
