



Warren Township Recreation Celebrates World Tennis Day

In celebration of “**World Tennis Day**” March 21, 2016, the Warren Township Recreation Commission will be hosting a free tennis clinic **geared for new students of the game**, for ages 4 to 17, showcasing the latest teaching tools that are widely used by the USTA. It is open to Warren, Watchung and Green Brook residents who have not joined our program previously. We will be demonstrating 10 & under tennis which utilizes smaller rackets and low compression tennis balls which make the game easier for kids to learn plus beginner skills for above 10. Tennis is a lifetime sport and is a great source of exercise and a great way to meet people.

The free clinic will take place on Monday, March 21st from 5-7pm at Warren Middle School gymnasium, 100 Old Stirling Rd, Warren. Clinic for ages 4-10 will run from 5-6pm and for ages 11-17 from 6-7pm. Parents are required to stay. Register free online at www.warrennj.org/recreation

Spring Tennis lessons also will be offered by the Warren Township Recreation Commission and taught by Tennis Pro Mike Watson. Registration will begin in March 1 at 1pm for Warren Residents and March 11th for Watchung Boro and Green Brook residents. There are (two) 6 wk (1hr) Spring sessions for ages 4-adults. Classes begin April 4 and May 16 for Session #2 with a registration deadline of March 30 at 10pm. **Also**, we will be running an 8 week Fall Tennis lesson beginning Sept 12.
