Klubhouse runs in accordance with the public school schedule beginning at school dismissal until 6:30PM. This includes care on half days as well. A flexible schedule is available. Klubhouse staff supervised bus transportation, provided by Fred Dealaman Bus Company, to our Warren sites is included in the daily fee along with nutritious snacks. All of our staff members are certified in First Aid, AED and CPR.

Typical Offering of Activities

- Supervised homework in a separate, quiet area with reference materials available.
- Quiet library area with soft seating and a large selection of age appropriate reading matter.
- Indoor/outdoor sports and games and/or free play in a park like setting.
- Arts and crafts, manipulatives, games and puzzles.
- Science projects, cooking and multi-cultural projects.
- Computers for homework and educational games.
- Community outreach ventures.
- Dramatic play area with dress up items and puppet theater.
