About our activities:

Science, Lego Building & Robotics Ages 6-12

Get ready for a fun-filled "magical" laboratory and Lego building experience. Science will come alive as you enjoy making Flubber, Silly Putty, Super Hi- Bounce balls, and more. Have fun making a "mushroom" monster, play dough, Glowing Goo, and even a tye-dye style shirt. Then challenge your building skill as you build a wide assortment of motorized and non-motorized Lego projects and invent a wide assortment of robots. Lego themes will include Star Wars, Friends, City, Nexo Knights, Minecraft, and more. *All campers will take home a mini- chemistry kit, recipe booklet as well as a Lego or robot project.*

Lunch Time:

Please pack your child a lunch, snack and drink. Water fountains are provided. Bring a reusable water bottle.

Drop off & pick up:

Drop off is at 8:45am. Please do not drop off more than 10 minutes early. The entrance will be off of Mt. Horeb Rd., drive to the side of the building and enter where you see the awning. This is the AP room. Do not park in front of the awning to drop off.

PICKUP time is 2:45pm. Please do not be late as the school closes the doors at 2:50pm. A late charge of \$5 for every 15 minutes per child will be charged to you if you are late.

Medical needs

Camp **will not** be able to administer drugs to your child, nor will we hold any medicine. Please administer medicine to your child either before and/or after the camp. If your child must carry **epi-pens** or inhalers, please notify our camp Instructor. If your child should get hurt, you will receive a medical report copy. Epinephrine/Epi-pens Authorization (if needed) and Parent Release forms need to be signed and mailed to the Recreation Department by Aug..3.

Emergency number:

When you arrive at camp the first day you will be given the cell number of the supervisor. You can also call the Recreation office at 908-753-8000 ext 270. There is no need to call if your child will be missing a day.

Conduct

The idea of camp is to have fun and be safe. Any behavior problems will be dealt with at the camp first, and parents will be contacted if the problem continues. The parent must come in with the child to meet with the Director. If the problem persists, the child will be asked to leave the camp.
