Toward that end, the Warren Township School District will be conducting a comprehensive audit of district and building communications with key audiences, identifying areas of strength and opportunities for improvement. As one of the initial components of the audit, we are inviting you to take the *SCoPE School Communication Survey for Parents*. Access the survey at https://goo.gl/sGjBYL on almost any computer or mobile device. Participation takes less than 15 minutes and is completely anonymous.

Because communication can differ from one grade to the next, we ask you to take a separate survey for each child you have enrolled in the district. Please be aware that Watchung Hills Regional High School is also conducting the SCoPE surveys. If you have a child enrolled at WHRHS, you should receive a separate invitation from them with the link to their separate surveys.

The SCoPE results will help us determine what practices are working well and should continue, as well as what practices can be improved upon.
