Week #1 June 25-29

Rebounderz: (Wednesday) TRIP TIME: 8:45am-2:45pm Campers will enjoy 2 hours of open gym and ninja warrior course. Lunch includes two slices of pizza, bag of chips, and a water bottle.

Monster Mini Golf: (Thursday) TRIP TIME: 8:45am-2:45pm One round of 18-hole monster glow mini golf and arcade game card. Lunch includes pizza and drink.

Week #2 July 2-6 (suggest bring \$20)

Dorney Park & Wildwater Kingdom Waterpark, Allentown, PA: (Thursday)

TRIP TIME: 8:15am-5pm Enjoy the waterpark in the morning (no wave pool) & amusement rides in the afternoon. (No wave pool allowed) Bring money for locker; need towel, sunscreen, water, snack, change of clothes; wear bathing suit to park. Lunch voucher included. Teens will be traveling on a coach bus.

Week #3 July 9-13 (Suggest bring \$10 for carnival day)

<u>Medieval Times:</u> (Wednesday) TRIP TIME: 8:45am-2:45pm Enjoy watching the live tournament and cheer on your knight. Lunch option is either chicken or vegetarian (pasta salad).

<u>Carnival Camp Day at Mt Olive:</u> (Thursday) TRIP TIME: 8:45am-2:45pm Enjoy 4 hours of rides and carnival games. Lunch voucher for a choice of hamburger, hotdog, or pizza with fries and a drink.

Week #4 July 16-20 (Suggest bring \$20)

Keansburg Amusement Park & Runaway Rapids: (Wednesday) TRIP TIME: 8:45am-4pm

About our staff:

- This camp is overseen for the seventh year by Director, Franco Caruso, a Certified Teacher with an Administrators Certificate, plus 2 Certified Teachers and 3 college students, and a Health Coordinator. For the safety of your teens, all adult staff are required to have CPR training. We follow State Health Mandated Regulations. CPR/AED/First Aid is required. Ratio 10 to 1.
- ❖ Our camp is lucky to have hard-working high school student volunteers known as Counselors in Training (CIT) throughout the summer.

About our camp:

This is a semi-organized camp. Teens are allowed to choose from a rts & crafts, games, sports, music or just socializing and much more. A Staff member is always within sight of the teens. Electronics are not permitted. If you want your child to have their cell phone the Director will hold it. Please see Director Franco about other arrangements the first day. You will receive an email each week from the Director with important information for that week. Please check your emails on your account and make sure our email is in your contacts to assure receiving all important announcements. recreation@warrennj.org

- Mondays & Tuesdays camp will be held at Round Top Swim & Tennis Club at 106 Mt Horeb Road. Activities include 1 & 1/2 half hours of swimming; other activities: volleyball, basketball, games, archery, tetherball, badminton, bocce ball, foosball, water basketball, Frisbee golf, table tennis, corn hole, kickball, dodgeball, and movies.
- ❖ NEW Trip days are on Wednesdays & Thursdays, meet at WHRHS 108 Stirling Rd. (Drop off and pick up at the Front entrance). For each trip lunch is included in the price.
- * Fridays at WHRHS they will have access to the gym and outside basketball court, baseball field, gaga pit, art room and theater room. They can be outside or inside (air conditioning).

Rain Changes: When it rains we do not cancel camp, however we will move the location or trip if needed. If a trip is canceled for rain, the trip will be rescheduled for Friday and the camp day will move to WHRHS for the day. If it rains on Monday or Tuesday (Round Top days) camp will be moved to WHRHS for the day. You will be notified by email by 7:15am (or by text if you are registered for it).

About special lunch and snack days:

- Mondays and Tuesdays <u>Lunch at</u> Round Top Swim & Tennis Club, you can bring your lunch or purchase lunch there for \$7.50 (bring cash both days). A menu will be provided before camp begins.
- Fridays is snow cone/ice-cream day for an extra fee, bring cash the day of (\$3-\$5).

Family Picnic:

This year the teen camp <u>will not be attending the Family Picnic</u> since they will be on a trip. Normally a tip jar is available at the Family Picnic for the CITs (Counselor in Training) who are volunteers. These CIT's do not get paid for their hard work and dedication. If you would like to tip a CIT each Friday there will be a tip jar available at the registration table. We will split the tips at the end of the summer based on how many hours the CIT worked so every CIT will receive a fair tip. This is not mandatory. Paid Staff may not be tipped.

Registration Instructions

- 1. <u>Warren Residents</u> have the opportunity to register before Watchung and Green Brook residents. Must show proof of residence on the first day (driver license, school ID or bill) Discount if you register early.)
- 2. This camp is a five-week teen camp for teens going into grades 6-8 by September. Pay by the week. Trips that are outdoors will be on Friday, if it should rain. (Note: Please indicate which grade your teen will be entering in September)
- 3. Fill in all requested information online or use UNIVERSAL form if mailing in check.
- 4. Registration deadline: June 19, 10pm or until the camp is full.
- 5. To pay by credit card (Visa or MasterCard), please go to http://register.communitypass.net/warrentwp or click on icon online at REGISTER at www.warrennj.org/recreation
- 6. To pay by check, make checks payable to "Warren Township" and mail check with your registration and parent release form to "Recreation Department," 46 Mountain Blvd, Warren, NJ 07059. Please call first to see if there is an opening.
- 7. Must sign, email, mail or drop off the **Parent Release form and Round Top Swim & Tennis Club form** one week before each camp week, They MUST be in before camp begins or expect a delay the first day of camp. Note: If your teen is attending the week with the trip of either Rebounderz, Keansburg, or Branchburg you will need to fill out an additional release form for the location in order for your teen to participate on the trip.
- 8. Please call the Recreation office at 908-753-8000 ext 270, if you have any special needs or need a scholarship.
- 9. You may not register at camp. You must register online or at the Recreation office or by mail. Only 48 openings. Register early as we fill early.

Camp Attire and Needs

Preferred camp attire is sneakers, hat for outside, sunglasses, and sun protection. No halter-tops, **short** shorts, or flip- flops (unless at a water park). Send your child with a water bottle and a towel (put name on them). Please, encourage your child to wear a **one-piece** bathing suit for Dorney Park & Keansburg. Teens may bring backpacks which will be safe on the bus. No radios, CD players, gaming devices, etc. are permitted. Cell phones should be turned off during trips, unless the parent and Director have a talked. Cell phones will be collected at the start of camp and returned at the end of the day. Pack a snack and drink for trips and lunch for other days.

Drop off procedure

Drop off your teen at 8:45am except for trip days since times vary. Please sign in your teen the first day of camp, then going forward you may pull up near WHRHS front entrance to drop off & pickup. For Round Top drop off at the end of the parking lot by the field.

Pick up procedure

Pick up your teen at 2:45pm except for the trip days since times vary. Please sign out your teen the first day of camp, then going forward you may pull up near WHRHS front entrance. Please pick up your child on time, as we have to pay coordinators extra to stay. If you are late, you will be sent a bill of \$5 for every 15 minutes per child. Parents may drop off and pick up their teen anytime between the hours allowed. For Round Top pick up at the end of the parking lot by the field.

Walking & Bike Riding Procedure

Your teen will only be allowed to walk or ride a bike to and from camp after the parent sends a signed consent letter to the Recreation Director, stating that you understand that the staff is only responsible for your child while he/she is at camp. Once your teen leaves camp, he/she may not return for the day. They **mav not** leave to get something to eat and come back, unless the parent signs him/her in and out. If someone other than your family is picking up your child, you must provide a note. See note and other forms on our website under Recreation, Forms.

Medical needs

The camp <u>will not</u> be able to administer drugs to your child, nor will we hold any medicine. Please administer medicine to your teen either before and/or after the camp. If your teen must carry **epi-pens** or inhalers, please notify our camp Health Coordinator. If your child should get hurt, you will receive a medical report copy. The Coordinators are CPR/First Aid-certified. Epinephrine/Epi-pens Authorization (if needed) and Parent Release forms need to be signed and mailed to the Recreation Department by June 20th. All forms are available online at www.warrennj.org/recreation Go to FORMS.

Immunizations

According to N.J.A.C. 8:57-4, we must have the parent's signature that your teen has received his/her immunizations against diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, pertussis, mumps & rubella.

Conduct

The idea of camp is to have fun and be safe. Any behavior problems will be dealt with at the camp first, and parents will be contacted if the problem continues. The parent must come in with the teen to meet with the Director. If the problem persists, the teen will be asked to leave the camp. When registering, please read the **Discipline Policy**, which is also available online at www.warrennj.org/recreation Goto FORMS.
