## About our activities:

There will be a half day of each topic.

#### NEW – Super Science STEM Challenges

In this engineering camp, you will have fun integrating Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics by building and designing a wide range of gadgets, inventive machines, towers, crazy contraptions, and more. *Projects include:* The Great Tower Challenge, the Standing Cup Pyramid Challenge, design a hurricane proof tower, Wooden Coaster Challenge, Structural Engineering Challenge, Magnificent Marble Machine, and a host of other fun contests designed to bring out the engineer in you! **Students will take home several of the projects built in class.** 

#### **LEGO Star Wars & Motorized Machines**

LEGO enthusiasts, have fun building your favorite adventure from a Star Wars galaxy that is far, far away. Star Wars projects will vary depending on availability from LEGO headquarters, but will include age-appropriate new models and the best of some of the older models. Campers will also

build a wide assortment of non-Star Wars motorized LEGO Education technic machines and create their own projects that illustrate science concepts. Examples include cranes, remote controlled cars, a player piano, and many more. This is a stimulating enrichment program and not geared as a teacher- driven education class. **All campers will take home a LEGO Star Wars project.** 

## Lunch Time:

Please pack your child a lunch, snack and drink. Water fountains are provided. Bring a reusable water bottle with your child's name on it.

## Drop off & pick up:

**Drop off** is at 8:45am. Please do not drop off more than 10 minutes early. The entrance will be off of Mt. Horeb Rd., drive to the side of the building and enter where you see the awning. This is the AP room. Do not park in front of the awning to drop off.

**PICKUP** time is 2:45pm. Please do not be late as the school closes the doors at 2:50pm. A <u>late charge</u> of \$5 for every 15 minutes per child will be charged to you if you are late.

## Medical needs

Camp **will not** be able to administer drugs to your child, nor will we hold any medicine. Please administer medicine to your child either before and/or after the camp. If your child must carry **epi-pens** or inhalers, please notify our camp Instructor. If your child should get hurt, you will receive a medical report copy. **Epinephrine/Epi-pens Authorization** (if needed) and **Parent Release forms** need to be signed and mailed, emailed or faxed to the Recreation Department by Aug.1.

### Emergency number:

When you arrive at camp the first day you will be given the cell number of the supervisor. You can also call the Recreation office at 908-753-8000 ext 270. There is no need to call if your child will be missing a day.

## Conduct

The idea of camp is to have fun and be safe. Any behavior problems will be dealt with at the camp first, and parents will be contacted if the problem continues. The parent must come in with the child to meet with the Director. If the problem persists, the child will be asked to leave the camp. ### Immunizations

According to N.J.A.C. 8:57-4, we must have the parent's signature that your child has received his/her immunizations against diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, pertussis, mumps & rubella or a letter stating you do not get the shots because of your beliefs.
