About our staff:

This is "Super Science Program's for Kids" 11^{th} year here in Warren. Back by popular demand... The staff is highly trained with CPR/First Aid/AED/Epi-Pen training. Fingerprints are provided.

About our activities:

There will be a half day of each topic.

Have fun building and creating a wide variety of motorized Lego Technic machines and mechanisms. Projects include a motorized player-piano, a car, a crane, amusement park rides, and projects that you design and create. Students will also build motorized, app-controlled and coded Lego projects such as a cat, guitar, and Vernie the robot. In this program, you will also have fun constructing a Battle-Bot from our huge Robotix modular collection, participating in our robot tug-o' war, Olympic competition, soccer match, and more. Then take to the skies with mini drones, quadcopters, and more! Housing a thrilling, hands-on aerial robotics platform, this camp is the perfect introduction to the world of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs). Campers will learn engineering principles in a fun, hands-on atmosphere. All participants will take home a mini-drone as part of this camp!

Lunch Time:

Please pack your child a lunch, snack and drink. Water fountains are provided. Bring a reusable water bottle with your child's name on it.

Drop off & pick up:

Drop off is at 8:45am. Please do not drop off more than 10 minutes early. The entrance will be off of Mt. Horeb Rd., drive to the side of the building and enter where you see the awning. This is the AP room. Do not park in front of the awning to drop off.

PICKUP time is 2:45pm. Please do not be late as the school closes the doors at 2:50pm. Please pick up your child on time, as we have to pay coordinators overtime to supervise your child. This late fee includes not only your own children but also those of whom you are picking up in addition. The first time you are late you will be given a warning. Any time after the first warning, you will be charged \$1 for every minute that has passed after the pickup window. This charge will be per child. You will then receive a slip stating how much will be charged on your Community Pass Account. If you have, any questions about the charge contact the Recreation Director **NOT** the Camp Director. Failure to pay the charges can result in dismissal from camp.

Medical needs

Camp **will not** be able to administer drugs to your child, nor will we hold any medicine. Please administer medicine to your child either before and/or after the camp. If your child must carry **epipens** or inhalers, please notify our camp Instructor. If your child should get hurt, you will receive a medical report copy. **Administration of Prescription Authorization** (if needed) and **Parent Release forms** need to be signed and mailed, emailed or faxed to the Recreation Department by Aug.2.

When you arrive at camp the first day you will be given the cell number of the supervisor. You can also call the Recreation office at 908-753-8000 ext 270. There is no need to call if your child will be missing a day.

Conduct

The idea of camp is to have fun and be safe. Any behavior problems will be dealt with at the camp first, and parents will be contacted if the problem continues. The parent must come in with the child to meet with the Director. If the problem persists, the child will be asked to leave the camp. According to N.J.A.C. 8:57-4, we must have the parent's signature that your child has received his/her immunizations against diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, pertussis, mumps & rubella or a letter stating you do not get the shots because of your beliefs.
