

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Programs are open to kids with a developmental disability who reside in a participating municipality in Somerset County. (Call the TR office at 908 526-5650 to verify municipal eligibility or visit us at www.somersetcountyparks.org).
- Individuals registering for these programs must be 8 years of age at the start of this specific program, able to take their own medication, and independent in personal care. There will be no nurse on staff. Must be able to function in a group setting of 12:2. These weekly programs are not appropriate for those with oppositional/defiant behavior and/or a history of aggression or a high likelihood of aggression
- If you are applying for a scholarship, you must submit a deposit of \$25.00 per week long session when registering. Additional paperwork will then be sent to you for completion if necessary.
