**WEAPONS OF ANY TYPE MAY NOT BE PART OF A COSTUME EITHER WORN TO SCHOOL OR BROUGHT TO SCHOOL**

**Masks that cover a student's faces entirely are not allowed**

**Inflatable costumes are allowed as long as the students' faces are visible. The rule is that we need to be able to make eye contact and identify a student**

**Students must be able to change their clothes for physical education where applicable**
