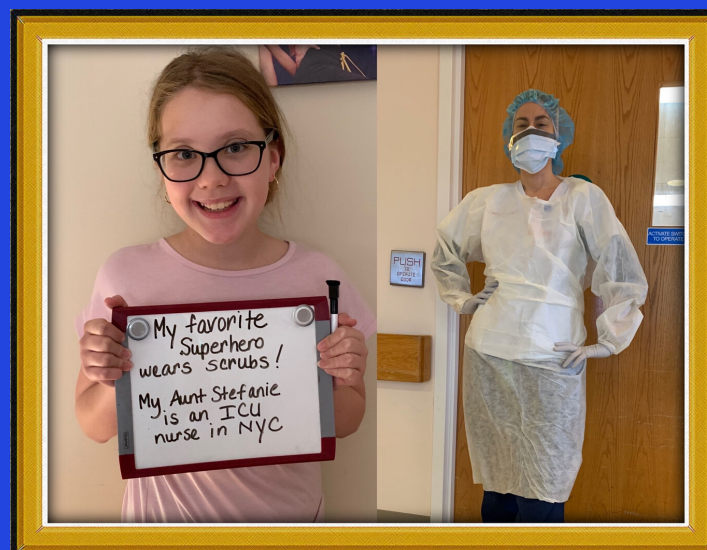
In conjunction with the school principals, teachers, and the Parent-Teacher Organizations, the students are participating in Spirit Days and challenges.

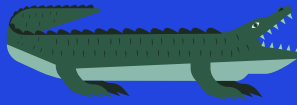
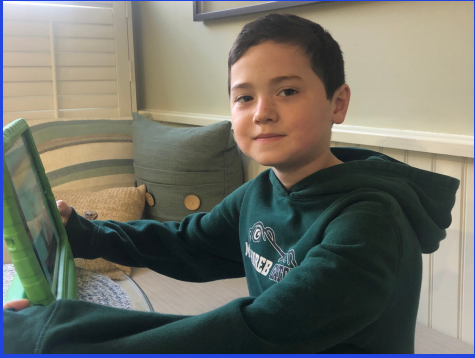


On Thursday, March 26, Woodland students participated in a Superhero Spirit Day.

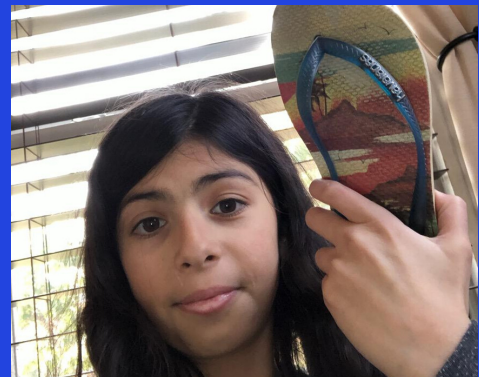
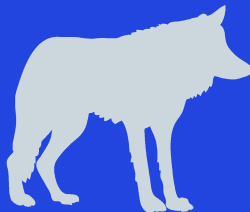

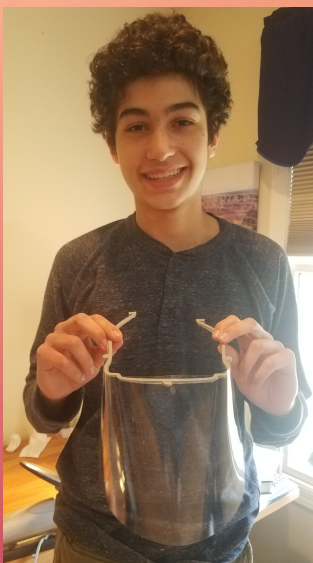
