WARREN TOWNSHIP SCHOOL BOARD ANNOUNCES CANDIDACY INFORMATION

The Warren Township School District has information available for citizens interested in running for the board of education.

The Warren Township Board of Education will have three vacancies in the November 8, 2022, Annual School Election. A full-term on the school board runs for three years. There are no other, unexpired terms on the Warren Township Board of Education at this time.

A candidate must file a nominating petition with the Somerset County Clerk for their name to appear on the ballot during the November Annual School Election. The deadline to submit the nominating petition is 4:00 p.m. Monday, July 25, 2022. The election is scheduled for Tuesday, November 8, 2022.

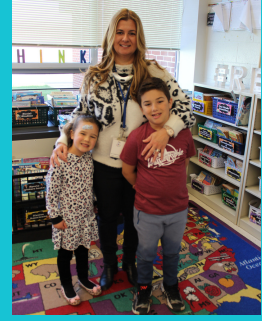
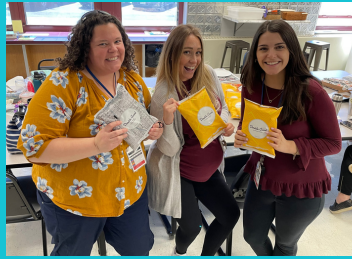

The School Board Candidate Kit includes information about nominating petitions, legal qualifications for school board candidacy, and the role of the school board member. Information about the New Jersey School Ethics Act and important dates in the school election process are also included.

"I encourage all interested citizens to consider school board membership. It doesn't require a degree in education or a background in politics. However, it does require a sincere interest in the community, its children, and their education."

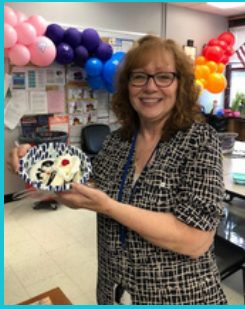

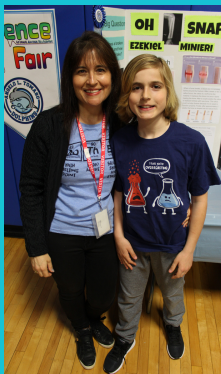

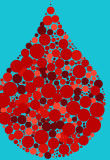
