

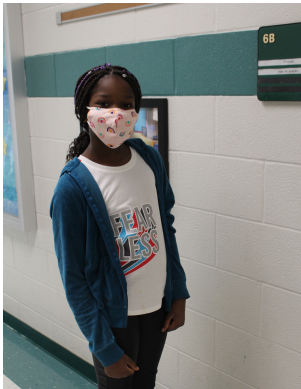

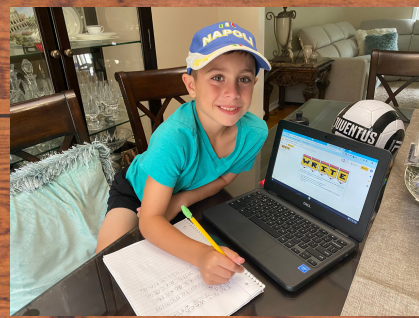

Outdoor team planning, outdoor classes, fresh air breaks, and wave parades!



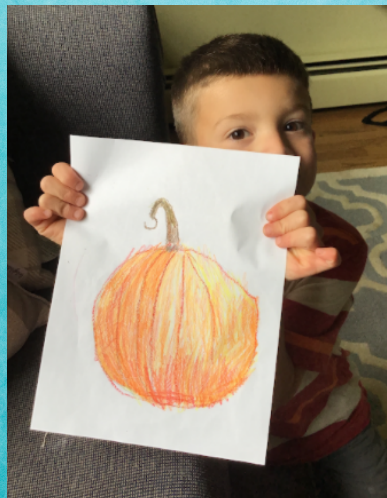
Good Deeds!

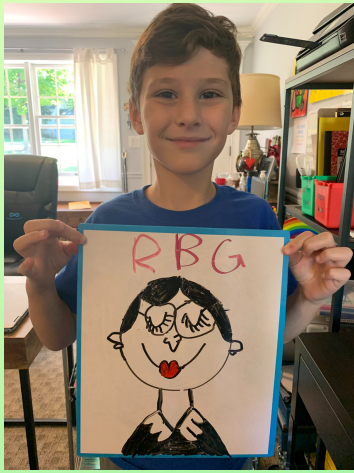
