Academic Support Courses

Academic Support classes are **free** of charge for Warren Township students who are identified by their classroom teacher as needing additional academic support. The goal of these classes will be to help students reinforce skills and maintain progress, so it is essential for students to attend on a regular basis.

Kindergarten Readiness: Offered to children entering kindergarten in September 2023, who are identified as requiring additional support for academic and social success by their current preschool teacher.

Kindergarten Review: Offers students who have completed kindergarten, and are recommended by their classroom teacher, a review of skills.

Integrated Language Arts: Offers students small group instruction focusing on print work, fluency, reading comprehension and writing skills.

Mathematics: Offers students small group instruction focusing on strategies for developing fluency of basic facts and problem-solving skills.



Enrichment Courses

Cost for Warren students: \$110 (per class period) per week

Cost for Out-of-district students: \$125 (per class period) per week

Teen Adventures

A program just for students grades 6-8. Attendees will socialize while learning new skills and training to be future volunteers for our Summer Fun Program. Teens will attend two periods of training and two periods of enrichment classes per day. **Students may sign up for one week or more.**

Extended Day Program 12:30 pm – 3:00 pm

The Extended Day program is supervised by certificated teachers and begins with a student-provided lunch. Children will have the opportunity to play games, enjoy movies, create art and participate in social activities.

Pre-registration is required. \$900 (entire program) or \$55 (daily rate)

After Care Program 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm

After Care is run by the same teachers and will be available following the Extended Day Program. Please make sure to send your child with a snack. Additional healthy treats will be provided along with additional activities.

Pre-registration is required. \$1000 (entire program) or \$65 (daily rate)



Enrichment Course Descriptions



Animal Planet - *Mr. M. Sebor* (Grades K-8) (*new course*)

Come visit our world where we'll explore the animal kingdom through tons of hands-on activities. Want to learn fascinating facts about cute, cuddly and even strange and scary creatures? Then this is the course for you. Through crafts, animal-related games, and mesmerizing stories you'll get to go on a creative adventure of a lifetime!

Arts & Crafts - *Ms. M. Stora De Cruz* (Grades K-8)

Do you like making crafts out of ordinary household items? Do you like getting messy and creative? Then this year's Arts and Crafts class is perfect for you! If you like using your imagination and don't mind getting your hands dirty, this class is everything you've been looking for! Come join us as we make summer-themed crafts that you'll want to keep for years to come!



Clay Works - *Mr. D. LaMorte* (Grades K-8)

Come be inspired with clay! Each week will offer unique projects from designing your own pots and sculptures, to making clay items to hang. We will create animals, monsters, and more! We will also paint our creations once they are dry! Don't miss out on making 3-D art while using a variety of clay, tools and techniques! Come catch the clay craze

Computer Graphics & Design - *Mrs. D. Porchetta* (Grades K-8)

Let's have some fun creating art on the computer! In this class you will have the opportunity to make designs which you can place in stationary, on cards or even create iron-ons for your clothes and back packs! Students will gain new computer skills while creating art! Join us and bring your artistic spirit as you make your very own graphic designs!

Cooperative Games and Adventure - *Mrs. A. Pellerin* (Grades K-8)

Come and enjoy this exciting course. Through cooperative games children will develop social skills while having the time of their lives. We will play games that focus on teamwork, foster self-esteem, develop creative problem-solving skills, and promote good sportsmanship. Some examples of games we will play are capture the flag, team tag games, human "Battleship", and more. Come make friends, learn new skills, and be challenged!

Creation Station - *Mrs. M. Flax* (Grades K-8) (*new course*)

Do you love to build, explore, and create? Then this course is for you! At the Creation Station, you will learn all about STREAM (Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Art, & Math) through exciting hands-on artistic projects. In this adventurous course you will get to build bridges, create models, origami inventions, gadgets, and so much more. Join us at the Creation Station where you can stretch your imagination to the limits!

Creative Gaming - *Ms. J. Andrews* (Grades K-8)

If you like playing games and working cooperatively with other students then you will love this course. Not only will you get to try classic board games such as Uno and Life but you will be able to play air hockey, knock hockey and other tried and true family favorites. If you feel inspired you may invent your very own games to try out with your fellow classmates. If you want to stretch your imaginative spirit, join us for a creative gaming adventure.



Discover Science - *Ms. C. Parolise* (Grades K-8) (*new teacher*)

Students will explore basic science principles in this engaging hands-on class. Through STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, and math) activities we will investigate, observe, and problem solve! Each day, participants will perform an experiment or participate in an activity to enhance their knowledge of the world. Using many ordinary household materials, we will discover the science behind slime, oobleck, bubbles, play-doh, parachutes, catapults, and more! Join us and discover just how cool Science can be!

I-Build with Legos! – Mrs. L. La Neve (Grades 2-8)

Do you like a good challenge? Are you someone who can figure out, fix, or solve problems? Do you like to design, construct and play with blocks, Legos and K'Nex? If so, then this is the class for you! In this STEAM-based class (science, technology, engineering, art, & mathematics) we offer hands-on problem solving, where you will be presented with a daily building challenge using various building sets. So, strap on your thinking cap and jump into the world of i-Build!



Jam Out! Ms. K. Backus (Grades K-8) (new course) (Must have parental media release approval)

Do you always find yourself singing along with songs on the radio? How about playing the air guitar, beatboxing, keeping a beat with your foot, or making up rhythms on your lap with your hands? Or do you already play an instrument? If you like to jam with songs on the radio, you'll love to join in the fun in *Jam Out!*. Jewelry Making for the Fashionista – Mrs. R. Sutherland (Grades K-8)

Do you love jewelry? Well, in this class you will be able to make your very own fashion accessories! Each week we will explore a new method of jewelry making to create bracelets, earrings, necklaces, and more using a variety of materials such as gems, crystals, metal, and safety pins. So bring out your inner fashionista and create amazing jewelry for yourself or your friends and family!

Just Dance – Mrs. C. Trump (Grades K-8) all skill levels welcomed!

Do you enjoy listening to popular songs on the radio? Does music get you moving? Then this is the class for you! It doesn't matter if you've been dancing for years or never set foot on the floor before. Each week, Mrs. Trump, a professional dancer with over ten years teaching experience, will have you performing a new routine. Let Mrs. Trump share her love of dance with you! Come out and just dance!!

Lights, Camera....Action! – Mrs. A. Jensen (Grades K-8) (Must have parental media release approval)

Calling all actors, actresses, and comedians! Do you like making up your own commercials, skits or TV shows? In this course you will create funny scenes with props and costumes! At the end of each week, you will have an awesome video of your performance to share with your family. This class is open to all creative students who like to make people laugh. Come and shine like a star!

Master Chef Academy – Ms A. McGuire (Grades K-8) (new teacher)

This exciting course is the perfect way to introduce young chefs to a culinary adventure. Throughout this course, students will collaborate with their peers while using critical thinking skills. Student will not only learn different cooking techniques and sample wonderful recipes, but they will also learn about healthy eating! (Allergy forms must be filled out and handed in on the first day of class.)

Picture Perfect Painting – Mrs. R. Davenport (Grades K-8)

Are you a budding Picasso or an aspiring Monet? Do you like art and want to experiment with paint? If so this class is for you! In this exciting course students get to learn about famous painters and try different types of paints, styles and techniques. So pick up a brush and palette and let your artistic abilities shine!





P.L.A.Y. – Mr. S. Ulichny (Grades K-8)

"Physical & Leisure Activities for the Young" is an energizing course where you can have fun and stay fit. Through indoor & outdoor sports and games such as Soccer, Kickball, Noodle Tag, Four Corners, Snow Castles and more!!!! Participants will have the time of their lives! Games are modified for children in the younger grades. So, come learn teamwork, cooperation, and self-expression while being physically active. It's time to P.L.A.Y.!!!

Puppet Master Theater– Mrs. M. Fishelman (new course)

Do you love reading and listening to stories? Do you enjoy learning about animals? Do you like to create? Then this is the course for you! Bring your favorite characters and animals to life with a variety of puppets. In this course, we will hear stories, both fiction and non-fiction. We will learn various techniques to create puppets such as wooden spoon puppets, sock puppets, finger puppets, rod puppets, stick puppets, hand puppets and paper bag puppets. At the end of each week, we will use our puppets to act out stories and non-fiction books.

Sketches & Scribbles: Art & Literature Magazine - Mrs. M. O'Donnell (Grades K-8) (new course)

Do you like making comics or creating art? Do you gather words all day long and want to share them? Join us as we put your talents on display by publishing a children's art and literary magazine. In this creative arts class, students get to choose writing or drawing or both! In this exciting class, students will plan, write, design, and publish their original comic strips, short stories, cartoons, and illustrations. Bring your creativity and join the staff of our Sketches & Scribbles Art & Literature Magazine.

Summer Fun Live – Ms. E. Maag (Grades K-8) (Must have parental media release approval)

Do you like creating videos, would you like to be a you tube influencer, sportscaster, reporter, or a tik-toker? Then this course is for you! Each week, students can create newscasts, talk shows, interviews, blogs and much more! Students will be able to pick a topic of their choice and research, plan, write, perform and edit their content for the world to see! So come make your dreams a reality!

Teen Adventures – Mr. P. Jones (Grades 6-8)

(Required to become future Summer Fun volunteers)

Let the adventure begin! This course prepares Counselors-In-Training (CITs) to become future volunteers for Summer Fun. CITs will engage in a team-based, problem-solving adventure incorporating technology and creative thinking. The class runs for the entire day *(all 4 periods)*. Teens will be enrolled in two periods of training with two periods of enrichment courses (enrichment courses will be selected by students when they arrive for their Teen program). **Attendees may sign up for one or more weeks.**



Trash to Treasure – Ms. J. Thomson (Grades K-8)

Do you like to build things? Are you creative? Then his class is for you.

Every week we will make art from materials found in your very own home. We will go on scavenger hunts to find recyclable materials that we can craft into amazing masterpieces. We will build robots, animals, collages, keepsake boxes, bridges and more. Come ready to turn your trash into treasure! ***If this class is for you, start saving recyclable materials such as paper towel rolls, plastic yogurt containers, bottle tops, bubble wrap, boxes, paper bags, colorful snack wrappers and any other materials you think you can build with.***

Tumbling, & Gymnastics – Mrs. S. O'Shea (Grades K-8) all skill levels welcomed!

Get ready to learn gymnastics skills with a certified USGA gymnastics trainer. Whether you are on a competitive team or are just looking to try it out, this class will be customized for you. Cartwheels, walkovers, handstands, handsprings...let's get tumbling! During this class, students will work on strength, flexibility, and basic tumbling skills.
