5. Principal's Report- Mrs. Tugya

- Spring 2018 Parcc- Parcc results
- May 2018 administered (4th year) 3-5 grade language Arts and Math- Reports are in percentages- 5 levels, looking to score in level 4 or 5. Overall we are in line with the whole district. Assessments are made to compare if there are any patterns in areas.
- Parcc was dropped- 2019 NJSLA was brought in. Major difference is, 1 unit in math and language arts was dropped and science will be administered in grade 5-8
- Accelerated Reader program suggested by parent at meeting- Mrs. Tugya will look into this.

Parking changes are in effect to keep everyone safe. *It is good practice to back into the parking spots for safety and bus traffic. This will be piloted through the winter. All of these measures are being put into effect with the objective of increasing parking lot safety to protect students, their families and staff.

Drop-off takes place at the blue awning by the APR door from 8:40-8:50 AM. Once buses begin unloading at 8:50, traffic will be held behind the unloading zone to ensure a clear lane for bus departure and maintain right of way for buses. • Once the APR door closes, parents will need to park and students will need to enter via the main entrance. Unloading at the APR concludes at 8:50.

Pick-Up • Any early office pickups must be completed no later than 3:10 PM and should be reserved for occasional use. After this time, lists have been distributed and staff is in action gearing up for the safe dismissal of our 300 plus students. Any pickups after 3:10 will be directed to the APR for dismissal at 3:20. • Parent pick-up takes place in the APR. APR doors will open by 3:15 so that parents/guardians may enter. Students will begin arriving at 3:20. • At 3:25, the APR door will close and incoming car traffic will be held behind the bus loading zone. This will allow time for cars with signed out students to depart the lot. Bus dismissal will commence at 3:30. The road and APR door will remain closed until all buses have safely departed, usually around 3:40 PM. • Once all buses have left, pick-up will resume
