Adult Social -almost \$11,000 which was about \$5,000 over the goal Kid Stuff Books- \$1625 which is about \$1,100 over goal of \$500 Membership donations-\$9727 which is about \$1700 over goal School Supplies boxes- \$2473 in revenue due to the credit from the mishap of incorrect items and late delivery LY (original goal of \$150)

Last year's expenses: \$45,635 budget \$33,779 result

Some reasons we came under budget:

LNO/DNO became an Income instead of an expense, raised about \$1500 Spirit wear became an income of about \$1500 instead of an expense Came under budget in Fifth grade event and yearbook Field Day was a lot less than anticipated, spent \$766 on a \$2500 budget

This year's budget: \$41,950 Income budget-pretty much in line with last year's budget \$41,060 Expense budget is about \$4500 than last year Decrease mainly due to decreasing field day to where it should be, Young Author is \$1,000 less than LY's Science day, PTO donation is caught up and back to \$1000 (we accumulated 2 years worth (\$2,000) last year because we never finalized a gift for the 2016-2017 year
