The Warren Township School District offers children attending kindergarten through eighth grade opportunities for enrichment activities and early, extended, and after care services for a fee. Academic support courses are available to Warren residents, free of charge, upon teacher recommendation. Enrichment and academic support courses are available for out-of-district students for a fee.

## Academic Support Classes

Academic classes are **free** of charge for Warren Township students who are identified by their classroom teacher as needing additional academic support. The goal of these classes will be to help students reinforce skills and maintain progress, so it is essential for students to attend on a regular basis.

**Cost for out-of-district students \$500 (grades 1- 8) \$800 (Kindergarten)**

**Kindergarten Readiness:** Offered to children entering kindergarten in September 2019, who were identified during kindergarten screening as requiring additional support for academic and social success.

**Kindergarten Review:** Offers students who have completed kindergarten, and are recommended by their classroom teacher, a review of skills.

**Integrated Language Arts:** Offers students small group instruction focusing on print work, fluency, reading comprehension and writing skills.

**Mathematics:** Offers students small group instruction focusing on strategies for developing fluency of basic facts and problem solving skills.



## Enrichment Courses

**Cost for Warren students: \$75** (per class period) per week

**Cost for Out-of-district students: \$85** (per class period) per week

### Super Saver Discount

**Sign up for one class period for all 5 weeks and save!**

**Students may select a different class each week!**

**Warren students: \$300** (per class period) for all five weeks. **(\$75 off)**

**Out-of-district students: \$340** (per class period) for all five weeks. **(\$85 off)**

### Sibling Discount

The first child in a family pays full price. Additional children receive **10% Discount**.

### Early Bird Discount

Additional **10% off** total payment if register and pay in full by **May 3, 2019**.

### Teen Adventures

This camp program is designed just for Middle School students. In Teen Adventures attendees get to socialize while learning new skills while training to be future volunteers and aides for our Summer Fun Program. Teens will attend two periods of training (period 1 & 2) and two periods (period 3 & 4) of student – selected enrichment classes.

**Students must sign up for all four periods per week, but are not required to attend all five weeks.**



### Early Care Program 7:00 am – 8:30 am

The Early Care program is supervised by certificated teachers.

It provides children the chance to play games, create art, and relax with other students.

Pre-registration is required. **\$350** (entire program) or **\$25** (daily rate)

### Extended Day Program 12:30 pm – 3:00 pm

The Extended Day program is supervised by certificated teachers and begins with a student-provided lunch. Children will have the opportunity to play games, enjoy movies, create art and participate in social activities.

Pre-registration is required. **\$550** (entire program) or **\$35** (daily rate)

### After Care Program 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm

After Care is run by the same teachers and will be available following the Extended Day Program. Please make sure to send your child with a snack. Additional healthy treats will be provided along with additional activities.

Pre-registration is required. **\$650** (entire program) or **\$40** (daily rate)



## Enrichment Course Descriptions

### **A Star is Born- Ms. A. Pech (Grades K-8) New Course**

Do you love to be on stage? Do you like being the center of attention? Than this course is for you. Each week students will work on a one-act play which they will perform live on Friday! In this fun filled class students will learn how to improve their acting skills, vocal expression and so much more! In preparation for the performances students will play theatre games, work on costumes and practice, practice, practice! So join us and let your inner star shine!

### **Animal Planet - Mrs. W. Piller (Grades K-6)**

Touch down on our amazing Planet where we'll explore the animal kingdom through tons of hands-on activities. Want to cook up some tasty treats like chocolate mice or edible butterflies? Through cooking crafts, animal-related games, pet-themed films, and mesmerizing stories you'll get to go on a creative adventure of a lifetime!

### **Arts & Crafts – Ms. D. Riccio (Grades K-8) New Teacher**

### **Computer Graphics & Design – Mrs. D. Porchetta (Grades K-8)**

Let's have some fun creating art on the computer! In this class you will have the opportunity to make designs which you can place in stationary, on cards or even create iron-ons for your clothes and back packs! Students will gain new computer skills while creating art! So join us and bring your artistic spirit as you make your very own Graphic Designs!

### **Cooperative Games and Adventure – Mr. P. Jones (Grades K-8)**

Come and enjoy this exciting course. Through cooperative games children will develop social skills while having the time of their lives. We will play games that focus on teamwork, foster self-esteem, develop creative problem solving skills, and promote good sportsmanship. ### **Creative Gaming - Ms. J. Andrews (Grades K-8)**

Using general art supplies, and modern technology such as; i-Build, coding, green screens, and stop motion, you will get to invent exciting new games that you can try out with your fellow classmates. So if you like to stretch your imaginative spirit, join us for a creative gaming adventure.

### **Creative Writing and Bookmaking – Ms. C. Ticchio (Grades K-8) New Course**

Do you love a good story? Do you want to write one? Then this is the class for you. Each week will center on a different literary genre. Week 1 we will explore fantasy and create magical tales. Week 2 we will laugh our butts off as we create comic writing. Week 3 we will study spooky tales and scary mysteries. Week 4 we will focus on fairytales and myths. Week 5 is all about action, where superheroes overcome their foes. So join us on a literary odyssey and let your creativity soar!

**i-Build– Mrs. L. La Neve (Grades 2-8) New Course (combined Steam Tank & Innovation Station)**

Do you like a good challenge? Are you someone who can figure out, fix, or solve problems? Do you like to design, construct and play with rolling, twirling or flying machines? If so, then this is the class for you! In this STEAM-based class (science, technology, engineering, art, & mathematics) we offer hands-on problem solving, where we create cool projects using recycled materials & K'NEX sets. So strap on your thinking cap and jump into the world of i-Build!

**Jewelry Making for the Fashionista – Mrs. R. Sutherland (Grades K-8)**

Do you love jewelry? Well, in this class you will be able to make your very own fashion accessories! Each week we will explore a new method of jewelry making to create bracelets, earrings, necklaces, and more using a variety of materials such as gems, crystals, metal, and safety pins. So bring out your inner fashionista and create amazing jewelry for yourself or your friends and family!

**Just Dance – Mrs. C. Trump (Grades K-8) all skill levels welcomed! Back by popular demand!**

**Summer Fun Live – Ms. M. Wolkun (Grades K-8) New Course (Must have parental media release approval)**

Students can create newscasts, talk shows, interviews, advertisements and much more! Students will be able to pick a topic of their choice and research, plan, write, perform and edit their content for the world to see! So come make your YouTube dreams a reality at SFL -Summer Fun Live!

**Teen Adventures – Mr. P. Jones (Grades 6-8) (Required to become future Summer Fun volunteers)**

Let the adventure begin! This course prepares Counselors-In-Training (CITs) to become future volunteers for Summer Fun. CITs will engage in a team-based, problem-solving adventure incorporating technology and creative thinking. The class runs as a double session, followed by two periods of self-selected enrichment courses where teens can pick any of our selections so they can learn, explore and "hang" with friends! **Attendees must sign up for all four periods for one or more weeks.**

**Tumbling, Cheerleading & Gymnastics – Mrs. S. O'Shea (Grades K-8) All skill levels welcomed!**

If you are a cheerleader here is a great opportunity to improve your tumbling skills. Get ready to learn gymnastics skills with a certified USGA gymnastics trainer.
