Dear Parents and Staff:

This letter is a follow-up to my letter of March 18, 2019, whereby I referred to the results of the Mt. Horeb School radon testing. As you may recall, Room 18B had a reading of 4.8pCi/L, slightly above the recognized threshold of 4.0pCi/L.

Per the NJDEP, the recommended course of action is a second test, with the average of the two readings then considered to be the result. As the second test yielded 1.0pCi/L result, the average is 2.9pCi/L.

We believe the high initial reading was due to an exhaust fan not operating properly in the room.

The district now considers its district-wide radon testing to be complete.
